

OSLO IN ONE ACCORD DECREE

We acknowledge that He is the God of Israel who promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Genesis 13:15; 15:5; 22:17; Gen 28:13-14; Deut 1:8; 30:5; Lev 26:42; Neh 9:8, Ezek 36:24-26; 37:21-25; 39:28; Heb 11:8-12); a land for Israel to inherit -- to keep, to protect and to preserve.

Acknowledgement and Declaration of The Holy One of Israel, His Authority and Supremacy

As nations that are represented and responsible for the ratification and execution of the Oslo Accords, September, 13, 1993, we as God's ekklesia hereby agree that God is above all power, all nations, all authorities, all thrones, all rulers and all governments. (Ephesians 1:21; Colossians 1:15-20).

Acknowledgement of the Size of the Land

We acknowledge that God identified the specified size of the land that Israel would inherit. He promised these specific boundaries to the Jewish people as it is written in Genesis 15:18-21. God later affirmed this promise to Moses in Deuteronomy 34:1-4 and to Joshua in Joshua 1:4.

Aim of the Solemn Assembly

1. Holy Agreement with God's Word and promises to Israel

In humility before God, we as God's kingdom ambassadors from different nations, do gather here in the city of Oslo for this solemn assembly on 15-17 September 2023 during the Feast of Trumpets, to make holy agreement and alignment with God regarding His promises to the Jewish People about the land He intended to give them.

As God's ekklesia, we agree that God's promised size of the land to the Jewish people is non-negotiable. Therefore, we recognize that any attempt to divide, to steal, to compromise that land for peace is a violation of God's word and a mockery to His promise and supremacy.

We acknowledge and agree with God that the Oslo Accords are largely responsible for dividing the land of Israel. This was intended by the negotiators of the Accords, who willingly compromised Judea and Samaria (the West Bank), as well as the Gaza Strip, with the intention to allot that land to the Palestinian Authority, for them to self-govern as a separate state from Israel. We acknowledge that this resulted in the reduction and diminishing of the size of the land from what was

already reduced land, compared to the land that was originally promised to the Jewish people.

We further acknowledge that because of these Accords, Israel withdrew from four settlements in Samaria, as well as from seven Israeli cities in Judea and Samaria (the West Bank), along with a full withdrawal from the Gaza Strip. The Accords left the governmental oversight ambiguous, setting up the region for further terrorist attacks and two Palestinian Uprisings stopping any further withdrawals.

We acknowledge and agree that the attempt to achieve "peace" in Israel, under the assumption of a compromise plan consisting of "land for peace", is in direct contradiction to the Word of God and in violation of His covenant promises to the Jewish People.

We acknowledge and agree with God that our foolishness led to more bloodshed, violence and war in Israel instead of peace.

2. Repentance and Renunciation

In the spirit of humility and repentance before God, as the Body of Christ in the Gentile nations, we repent for our failure to preach, teach and give clarity to people in regard to the Lord's will, purposes and promises to Israel related to the land. This promoted ignorance and pride among the people of the Gentile nations, as well as bloodshed, death, and suffering in Israel.

We repent for our naivete to compromise the land that God promised to Israel as His nation and people. As believers from Norway, we ask for forgiveness for our undiscerning attitude, and for using our peacemaking ability as a nation to lead Israel to false peace.

We acknowledge as Gentile nations that we supported the Oslo process, which became largely responsible for the division of the land of Israel, resulting in increased terrorism rather than peace and security. We repent for our presumptuous acts in initiating and facilitating the Oslo Accords that compromised not only the portion of the land given to Israel, but also the heart of the land - Jerusalem.

We acknowledge Jerusalem, God's beloved Zion, as the city of the Holy One of Israel; the city where all the nations will gather to worship Him (Jeremiah 3:17). We acknowledge that there is no **god other than the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob (Israel)** that can claim Jerusalem as their own. And no other people group that can claim Jerusalem as their inheritance, except those who have called the God of Israel, YHVH, as their LORD.

Therefore, we repent for compromising the city of YHVH (*Psalm 101:8; Jeremiah 31:38; Isaiah 60:14*), which God appointed as the

city where He will sit on His throne, and dwell in, upon His return as the King of Kings and Lord of Lords of Israel and the nations (Zechariah 3:2, Psalm 68:16; Psalm 132:13-14).

We repent for leaning on our own understanding, for our human zeal and well-meaning intentions that are not aligned with your will and purposes for Israel. Forgive us for denying them the heritage that you have given them. We call it a sin and iniquity in providing them "peace" that is not from you. We seek your forgiveness to us as nations that are responsible for the trouble that the Oslo Accords has caused them.

On behalf of the nations gathered here, on the occasion of the thirtieth anniversary of the Oslo Accords, we repent for tolerating replacement theology; for our antisemitic mindset, persuasion and beliefs. We repent for our silence, fear of man, and any known desire to divide the land. We repent for our false understanding of peace that led to the division of the land of Israel.

We acknowledge that because of our nations and their participation in the Oslo Accords, we are guilty for entering into the stealing of the land, which is under Your ownership Lord; which is the inheritance You have given Israel. We acknowledge that we have sinned greatly against You, against Your covenant promises to Israel, against your plans and purposes regarding the borders of Israel, against your covenant people – the descendants of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

For all the wicked things we have thought and done against Your people, we repent for each one of them. We acknowledge Your mercy O God, to forgive and restore. Therefore, we receive Your forgiveness; and receive the restoration you have intended for us; and Your desire to heal Israel as a nation along with all of us from the Gentile nations who acknowledge You as the Holy One of Israel, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords of Israel and the nations.

3. Declaration of A New Decree by the Ekklesia from Oslo

We ask O God that you will anoint every declaration and decree that we believe we have received from you on this occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Oslo Accords. We consecrate this day as Your divine **reversal** to favor the nation of Israel -- to receive and possess the full inheritance You promised to her forefathers.

On this Yom Teruah (Feast of Trumpets) 15th – 17th of September, 5784 of the civic Jewish New Year, here in the city of Oslo, we as the ekklesia of God from the Gentile nations, in holy agreement with the God of Israel, agree together in unity to make known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places our declaration and decree.

As watchmen from Norway, the nation that is largely responsible for the Oslo Accords; and for the rest of us from the Gentile nations, we declare our full and holy agreement with God to stand for and with Israel, and contend for the fullness of her spiritual and material inheritance as Your people in Your covenant land.

We declare that the God of Israel will gather His people Israel (the Jewish People), from the east, from the west, from the north and from the south and bring them back to the land that You have given to their forefathers. We declare that You will draw them to settle there in safety, security and peace.

We declare that You, our God, will turn back Israel's enemies and break every word spoken by her enemies against her. We decree that Israel's borders will be enlarged and extended according to Your design and sovereignty. We decree that Israel's borders and rightful territory will expand and that it will be enough land for the influx of Jews that will return to settle there.

We declare that the land of Israel will be blessed with true peace that You, our God, desires for her to enjoy. On behalf of our government leaders, as watchmen, ekklesia and ambassadors of the Kingdom of God, we declare that no longer will her land be taken from her, nor be divided by any governmental power or authorities from the Gentile nations. Furthermore, we declare that Israel will no longer be required to retreat from land; nor withdraw from land; nor expel her citizens from land, due to pressure from any nation or any entity.

We declare and decree that our nations will refuse to take part in causing Israel to compromise the land You have promised to her because You will raise us up as sheep nations, to stand with her for her welfare just as Ruth sought the welfare of Naomi. We declare that the land of Israel will be protected from any nation that would attempt to steal her borders and from any evil scheme that would wittingly and unwittingly divide the land that was originally promised to her through Your covenants with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

We declare that we will seek Israel's peace and defend it to the best of our ability and knowledge with the help of You, our Almighty God.

We decree and declare that all deceit, all wicked and evil systems conceived from the Gentile nations that empowered and enabled evil to oppress and destroy Israel, are now uprooted and

eradicated. We declare that such wicked root systems will never grow again.

We declare and decree that Norway as a peacemaking country will use her calling for true peace and reconciliation between nations and that You O God will redeem the mistakes she has done in the name of peace. We declare and decree Norway to function like Ruth to Naomi and that Norway's new role, as a sheep nation will be to carry the cause of Your promises given to Your covenant nation, Israel, to all national and international forums; and speak of those promises with nation leaders.

We declare from this day forward, that this solemn assembly will bring shift in the nations and in the heavenly activity of God in favor of Israel, and the God-given destiny of our nations will be released.
